On Christmas eve when I come to deliver your toys (if you are on the good list), I will take your elf back home with me. If you have done a good job looking after him, I might let him come back next year.

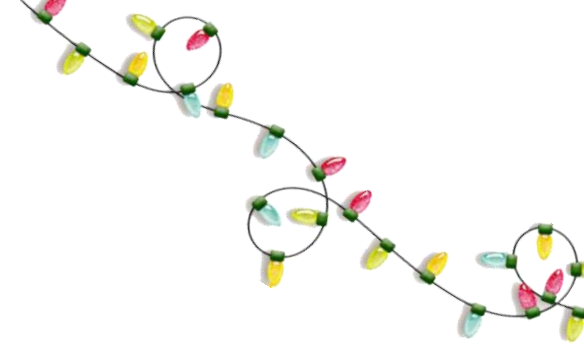
